On 11/11/2014 at 4:59 PM Carver police were dispatched to the area of 34 Main St. for a reported hit and run motor vehicle accident. Upon the arrival of emergency responders it was discovered that a 14 year old Carver girl had been struck by a motor vehicle. The vehicle involved did not stop after striking the child and continued south bound on Rte. 58. At the time of the incident the child had been walking with friends who were able to tell police what had happened.

Parts from the MV that had struck the child were recovered from the scene. Police were able to determine the make and color of the vehicle involved from the recovered parts.

A broadcast was immediately put out to area departments. As a result of the broadcast and with the assistance of the Wareham police and the Mass State Police a vehicle was located at a residence in Wareham. The operator of the vehicle was identified as a woman in her 70s from Wareham.

As a result of being struck the child, who did not appear to have life threatening injuries, was transported to Boston Medical Center by Carver EMS.

The incident is still under investigation by Sgt. Sheri Sarmiento of the Carver Police Department.
